Supporting young people to overcome barriers,

Across the UK, the number of young people with **social, emotional and mental health needs (SEMH) and SEND support requirements** is climbing, yet the provision available for them has not grown at the same pace.

Many young people are disengaging, withdrawing and becoming at risk of NEET*

Seetec's Alternative Education model offers **early intervention, specialist support and a structured pathway back into education, employment and training.**

Who we support

- Young people with **SEMH barriers.**
- Young people with SEND support needs or an **Educational Health and Care Plan.**
- Students experiencing **emotional-related school avoidance.**
- Those disengaged, at **high risk of NEET**, or struggling in mainstream environments.

Our core aim is **gradual inclusion**, leading to successful engagement with mainstream services and long-term, positive future.

We work to ensure **every young person** is supported, empowered and able to progress.

Encourage community participation and belonging.

Access to real-world projects, volunteering and social engagement helps develop responsibility, purpose and connection.



Improve wellbeing, self-management and resilience.

Reducing stress and a focus on self-care will promote emotional stability and personal growth.



Delivery Model

Our three-phase pathway integrates **support, structure and gradual transition**:

Phase 1 – 1:1 Mentoring and support

Personalised sessions to explore strengths, interests and barriers. Focus on wellbeing, emotional regulation, confidence and re-engagement.



Phase 2 – Structured Programme

Small-group and individual activities designed to develop:

- Routine & attendance
- Social confidence and communication
- Skills for education, work & independence
- Emotional resilience and self-belief

Progress is reviewed regularly to ensure readiness for next steps.



Phase 3 – Transition Into Education, Employment or Training

Supported move into:

- Further education or training
- Work experience or employment pathways
- Volunteering and community engagement

Follow-on mentoring ensures sustained progress and positive outcomes.
